

How the Games Work

Let it Ride Poker

Keep it fun.
Learn how the games work before you play.

Let It Ride is a version of Five-Card Stud. You win if your hand contains a pair of 10s or better. You don't play against other players or against the dealer.

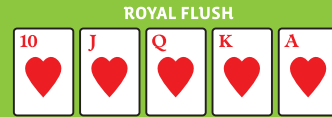
Each player places three equal bets in the circles marked 1, 2 and 5. All cards are dealt face-down. Each player receives three cards and the dealer takes two cards which will be used as community cards by the players. After looking at your first three cards, you may take back your first bet or you may keep it in play, commonly referred to as *Let it Ride*.

The dealer turns over one of the two community cards. This becomes the fourth card of your hand. Again, you can take back your second bet or *Let it Ride*. Finally, the dealer turns over the second community card as the fifth card of your hand, and pays all winners. And there's a bonus game, too! Before cards are dealt, you can put a \$1 chip in the bonus bet circle and based on your hand you could win up to \$20,000.

Let It Ride Payout Chart

Winning Hands	Basic Game Payout	Bonus Game Payouts
Royal Flush	1,000 to 1	\$20,000
Straight Flush	200 to 1	\$2,000
Four of a Kind	50 to 1	\$100
Full House	11 to 1	\$75
Flush	8 to 1	\$50
Straight	5 to 1	\$25
Three of a Kind	3 to 1	\$8
Two Pairs	2 to 1	\$4
Pair of Tens or better	1 to 1	N/A
