

How the Games Work

Roulette

Keep it fun.

Learn how the games work before you play.

The roulette wheel consists of numbers 1 – 36, alternately coloured red and black, plus 0 and 00, which are green. The dealer spins the Roulette wheel and spins the ball in the opposite direction. To win, you must predict where the ball will come to rest on the Roulette wheel.

Wagers can be placed on individual numbers or groups of numbers. To bet, place your chips on the numbered table layout. Inside bets are made with non-value chips, which you must purchase from the dealer prior to placing your bet. Outside bets are made with value chips or non-value chips. Bets can be made until the dealer announces, “No more bets.”

Once the ball comes to rest, the dealer marks the winning number on the layout and pays all winning bets.

INSIDE BETS:

- A. Single Number (Straight Up) Pays 35:1
- B. Two Numbers (Split) Pays 17:1
- C. Three Numbers (Street) Pays 11:1
- D. Four Numbers (Corner) Pays 8:1
- E. Five Numbers (Five line) Pays 6:1
- F. Six Numbers (Six Line) Pays 5:1

OUTSIDE BETS:

- G. Dozen Pays 2:1
- H. Column Pays 2:1
- I. 1 to 18 or 19 to 36 Pays Even
- J. Odd or Even Numbers Pays Even
- K. Red or Black Numbers Pays Even



TouchBet Roulette: Using a touch screen terminal, you can play Roulette on this visual and automated link to a real live Roulette game. Cameras are positioned above the Roulette table with the live action projected onto a screen.

To play, insert bank notes into the terminal. Credits (chips) will be automatically registered in the terminal and displayed on the screen. When the green Place Your Bets is shown on the screen, touch the screen where you want to place your chips – one touch = one chip, two touches = two chips, etc. The value of the chips staked will be deducted from your credits. Press 5x or 10x at the bottom of the terminal to increase your chip value.

The dealer on the live table spins the ball. When No More Bets is highlighted on the screen, it is not possible to change, add or remove chips for that spin. The terminal is locked out.

The winning number is highlighted in blue on the terminal and all winning bets are paid out. Your winnings are shown in the Win Box before being added to your credits. Choose whether to take your winnings (credits) or continue to play. To take the winnings, press the Cash button. A receipt is produced which you can exchange for cash at the cash desk.
