

How the Games Work

Three Card Poker

Keep it fun.

Learn how the games work before you play.

Bet against the dealer, on the value of your own three-card hand or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.

To play against the dealer, place an *ante* wager. After looking at your three-card hand you may *fold*, or if you think your hand beats the dealer, place an equal wager on the *play* spot. If your hand beats the dealer's qualifying hand of a queen or better, you win both wagers! If the dealer doesn't qualify, you win the *ante* wager and the *play* wager is a *push*.

To play the hand value only (not against the dealer), place a wager on the *pair plus* spot. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win.

To play both, bet the *ante* and *pair plus* spots. You must make a *play* wager if you have placed the *ante*, or forfeit the *ante*.

When wagering against the dealer, the following bonuses will be paid:

Ante Bonus Payouts

- Straight - 1 to 1
- Three-of-a-kind - 4 to 1
- Straight Flush - 5 to 1

Playing Against The Dealer

- Player Folds – Lose Ante and Pair Plus bet, if wagered
- Dealer Does Not Qualify – Play wager is a Push; Ante wager wins 1 to 1
- Dealer Qualifies and Player Hand Wins – Play wager wins 1 to 1; Ante wager wins 1 to 1
- Dealer Qualifies and Player Hand Ties Dealer Hand – Play wager and Ante wagers Push

Pair Plus Paytable

- Pair - 1 to 1
- Flush - 4 to 1
- Straight - 5 to 1
- Three-of-a-kind - 30 to 1
- Straight Flush - 40 to 1
