How the Games Work Three Card Poker

Keep it fun. Learn how the games work before you play.

Bet against the dealer, on the value of your own three-card hand or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.

To play against the dealer, place an ante wager. After looking at your three-card hand you may fold, or if you think your hand beats the dealer, place an equal wager on the play spot. If your hand beats the dealer's qualifying hand of a queen or better, you win both wagers! If the dealer doesn't qualify, you win the ante wager and the play wager is a push.

To play the hand value only (not against the dealer), place a wager on the pair plus spot. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win.

To play both, bet the ante and pair plus spots. You must make a play wager if you have placed the ante, or forfeit the ante.

When wagering against the dealer, the following bonuses will be paid:

Ante Bonus Payouts

- · Straight-1 to 1
- Three-of-a-kind 4 to 1
- · Straight Flush 5 to 1

Playing Against The Dealer

- Player Folds Lose Ante and Pair Plus bet, if wagered
- Dealer Does Not Qualify Play wager is a Push;
 Ante wager wins 1 to 1
- Dealer Qualifies and Player Hand Wins Play wager wins 1 to 1; Ante wager wins 1 to 1
- Dealer Qualifies and Player Hand Ties Dealer Hand – Play wager and Ante wagers Push

Pair Plus Paytable

- Pair 1 to 1
- Flush 4 to 1
- · Straight 5 to 1
- Three-of-a-kind 30 to 1
- Straight Flush 40 to 1
